Criteria and Application for Non-PhD Scholarship:

Oklahoma Mineral and Gem Society (OMGS) welcomes and invites qualified candidates in Earth Science Studies or Geology to apply for scholarships which will open September 1, 2023 and close at midnight of September 30th, 2023. The OMGS Board of Directors will choose one student from OU and one student from OSU to receive a scholarship in the amount of \$1000.00. The applications will be reviewed and decided upon at the October Board meeting, then distributions to each of the students will be made by October 31, 2023.

Scholarships are available to be used for tuition, books, educational fees or for summer Field Camp. We, in the Oklahoma Mineral and Gem Society, hope it is your intent to begin your career in the State of Oklahoma. Special consideration will be given to students who are involved in activities related to education of rocks and minerals or to those who have volunteered in the identification process of rocks.

CRITERIA:

1. Candidates must be classified as a junior or senior in the field of studies.
2. Must maintain a 3.0 grade point average in their determined degree of study (Geoscience classes or explain why the grade point is less than 3.0. OMGS understands that life circumstances have change priorities.
3. Must be attending Oklahoma University or Oklahoma State University.
4. Must be a U.S. citizen.
5. Must be a resident of Oklahoma
6. Must attend one Oklahoma Mineral & Gem Society general meeting which meet on the third Thursday evening of each month at 7:00 pm at 3400 NW 36th St., Oklahoma City to receive the scholarship check, or must volunteer at the annual OMGS Rocks Show or you must write a thank-you letter to OMGS. (OMGS recommends that you write a thank-you letter at this time)
